4) Old Business:

Corporation Status for the Idaho Alpine Club

Donna Whitham refiled with the Secretary of State to keep the Idaho Alpine Club as a Corporation Status. She distributed to the secretary (Susan McKinley) and president (Sam Pole) copies of the Annual Report Form for their files.

5) New Business:

Bulletin Distribution by Mail vs. Facebook

Sam Pole asked if more members preferred receiving IAC bulletins in their mail as opposed to receiving them on facebook. Donna Whitham said it seemed to be about a 50/50 split. She also mentioned that members need to remember to open "like" on the IAC site in order to receive it as a friend.

Summer of 2012 Peak Climbing

The council members discussed other peaks, such as: Bell, Southern Butte, Menan Butte, Diamond, Saddle, Table, and Taylor as examples. These climbs would be in preparation for the South or Middle Teton climbs. All the council members liked the idea of these peak climbs, and they will be advertised in the upcoming IAC bulletins.

IAC Activities not Posted in Bulletin

Roger Couch also mentioned that many of the IAC activities are not advertised in the bulletin. The council members discussed how this has been an issue in the past, also.
