IAC Council Meeting Minutes

1) Meeting call to order: 6:51 p.m.

2) Reading of previous meeting minutes: The minutes from the March council meeting were read by Susan. Nancy motioned to accept the minutes, Colleen seconded, and all present board members agreed.

3) Treasurer's Report for 01/01/26-12/31/26:

Katherine Coble emailed and read the financial report to the board

Total Inflows 01/01/26 – 12/31/26: \$ 295.53 (dues \$ 260.00, interest \$35.53)

Total Outflows 01/01/26 – 12/31/26: \$ 323.83 (\$200.00 - donation to Development Workshop, \$29.33 - speaker and mic, \$44.50 – printing business cards.)

Katherine reminded the board that our \$ 3,398.28 CD matures on May 9. The board agreed we should roll it over into another CD.

Susan motioned to accept the financial reports, Sam seconded the motion and all present board members agreed.

4) Old Business:

The planning committee met on Zoom on March 16 and planned events for the Spring of 2026, which was emailed to IAC members.

The Board discussed the upcoming August picnic plans. A committee was formed of Linda Moore, Kathie Thiel and Susan McKinley. They will meet to firm plans for this event. Susan will ask Kathie for a specific day during the third week of August to host picnic. Susan will check with barbecue places in town to order trays of chicken and pulled pork, which she will pick up. Katherine motioned to allow an expenditure of \$500 for supplies for the picnic, Mike seconded the motion and all present board members agreed. The board agreed that any board member who wins a raffle prize at the picnic, should limit what they accept to one item.

The board discussed plans for the IAC float trip. Sam had contacted two outfits: Barker-Ewing and Mad River. They both quoted him a price of \$105 per adult and \$90 a minor. These floats are about 4 hours long and they would need 8-12 people for trip. They both do the scenic route above the bridge from Moose, but Mad also does a u-paddle trip down the canyon. A raft trip committee was decided upon which includes Sam as the chairman, Dave, Mike, Nancy and Bob to finalize plans for this membership outing. They will have a zoom meeting on April 24th. Mike motioned to use \$1,000 of IAC checking account to pay for a limit of 20 participants, with an expectation of a \$50 deposit from each person, and the IAC club will pitch in the other \$50 cost. Colleen seconded this motion, and all present board members agreed. It was also decided that we will keep a waiting list after 20 participants pay deposits. If anyone must back out and we can replace them, they will be refunded their \$50. If no replacement, then not.

5) New Business:

Katherine motioned to transfer the \$398 interest amount out of the IAC CD (when it matures) into the IAC checking account. Sam seconded this motion, and all present board members agreed. This will help with all our upcoming expenditures.

Sam decided to schedule the IAC Highway 31 clean up on May 16. He will get in touch with Jeff Coward on helping with this event.

Nancy motioned to hold our future board meetings on every Monday following the General Meetings. Dave seconded this motion, and all present board members agreed.
